“Some moments ask us to pause and consider the weight of our choices. This is one of them.

What is happening in Palestine is not only the loss of life, but an attempt to erase a people and their history. Homes, schools, museums, and sacred places have been destroyed. In response, Palestinians hold on to what cannot be taken by force. Archivists preserve old photographs of Jerusalem. Poets recite the words of Mahmoud Darwish amid the ruins. Families pass down recipes like maqluba, and women continue stitching tatreez, each pattern carrying the memory of a village.

These acts may seem small, but together they are powerful. They say: we are still here. To stand with the women and children of Palestine is to stand for life, culture, and the right to exist. When chances to act with meaning are rare, this is a moment to choose compassion—and make it count. Free Palestine.”



